Staff has utilized millings to fill potholes on the road leading to Boat Ramp #2. Brush, mulch, and millings have been moved from Boat Ramp #1. Additionally, maintenance has been performed on the portable restroom.

2. Discussion and possible action on future park events

Discussion was held on the upcoming park events for budget year 2021-2022. Director Gyergyó reported that J-Town Street Fest will be held on September 25th, however the Fall Fest scheduled for October 23rd has been cancelled. The Spooky Movie in the park is

scheduled for October 30th. The Thanksgiving Luncheon is still being discussed, but that the Jonestown Hometown Holiday event is scheduled for December 3rd.

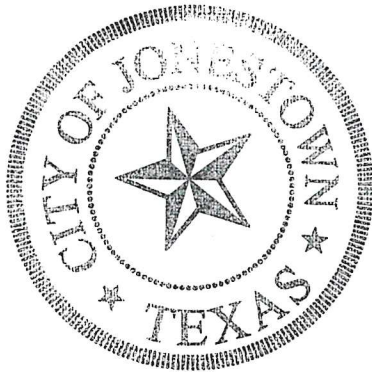
3. Discussion and possible action on the Jonestown Comprehensive Park Master Plan

D. ADJOURNMENT


