

*City of Jonestown, Texas*  
***Local Disaster Declaration***

**WHEREAS**, THE City of Jonestown on the 10th of July 2025, has suffered widespread damage and/or loss of property resulting from Flooding and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of Jonestown, Texas has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF JONESTOWN, TEXAS:**

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Jonestown, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of Jonestown, Texas.

The declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on July 10, 2025, shall be renewed and shall continue until terminated by order of the City Council.


Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
